



- It takes only 23 minutes to travel by train from Haneda International Airport to Yokohama


Topography of Expo Site

Foothills of forest







A tree survey will be conducted for the Expo site to study the uses for existing trees




Site Layout

Urban Development and Park construction projects are ongoing to start the construction works




Urban Development Infrastructure design

Site Configuration

- The site will not be divided by function into multiple zones
- The layout plan will consider organic linkages between site spaces and integration of the site with the surrounding landscape



Site Layout (Gardens)

- Gardens embodying the main theme/ natural features, culture, traditions etc. of each country and region
- Using the natural topography and greenery, Gardens will be placed along the major routes of movement



Site Layout (Exhibition / Event Facilities)

- Exhibition facilities that embody the Expo theme and display appealing exhibits will be provided.
- Event facilities for presenting official ceremonies and events sponsored by participants will be provided.





Competitions

- Competitions will be held for indoor and outdoor gardens and products
- They aim to improve horticultural techniques, nurture outstanding varieties, and promote the development of horticultural industry and culture
- Unique Expo competitions will also be held


