# All facilities must have secondhand smoke prevention measures based on the Health Promotion Act.



## Type I facilities

Targeted facilities > Schools, hospitals, pharmacies, child welfare facilities, government office buildings, etc.

### Requested measures

In principle, no smoking on the premises\*

\*As an exception, installation of designated outdoor smoking areas outside the building is permitted.

## Type II facilities

Targeted facilities Restaurants, offices, factories, hotels, etc.

(Other than a type I facility or facility for smokers\*) \*Bars and snack bars where the one of the main purposes is smoking, tobacco shops that allow smoking indoors, etc.

Smoke ventilating out

rooms and other facilities

only used by employees



In principle, no smoking Including non-public in indoor areas

As exceptions, the setting up of smoking rooms that fulfill criteria, as well as transitional measures for small restaurants (provided that they have been operating as of April 1st, 2020) are allowed.

### Technical criteria for setting up smoking rooms

- In the entrance, the flow of air coming in from outside to inside must be 0.2m or more every second
- Must be partitioned with walls, ceilings, etc. in order to prevent tobacco smoke from flowing out of the smoking room
- Stobacco smoke is ventilated outside or to an external area

### Types of smoking rooms

- Designated smoking rooms: eating and drinking not allowed.
- Thermal tobacco smoking rooms: eating and drinking allowed.

People under 20 years of age are not allowed to enter the smoking area

People under 20 years of age can not be allowed to enter the smoking area even if they are employees. For facilities where smoking is allowed\*, people under 20 years of age are not allowed to enter.

\*Restaurants that allow smoking in all areas inside, among small restaurants subject to transitional measures
