


e.g. leftover food and kitchen waste


Roughly <mark>80%</mark> of food waste is water! Please <u>drain the water</u> before disposal.



Tree branches, leaves & weeds



Cut and bundled



Weeds, leaves and twigs can be put together in semi-transparent bags

e.g. twigs, weeds, leaves & flowers

Cooking oil



Soak cooking oil into cloth/paper, or solidify it before disposal.

Plastic products e.g. video tapes, hair dryers, plastic toys, smaller than 50 cm in length Items with this logo ⇒ Plastic containers/packaging Non-recyclable clothes & textiles **Bags**, gloves, cushions, fur clothes, leather jackets, shoes, stained/torn clothes, etc. Other trash 50cm (maximum length) Cigarette butts, disposable chopsticks, wooden boards, medical pads, etc., 2






Acceptable items



lphaWrap items in nespapers, thick paper, or put in original packing boxess if available, and discard them by item type. Write the item type of the content (e.g. glass ceramics, fluoruscent light, etc.) on the wrapping



Fluorescent/incandescent lights



Place these items separately from other glass and ceramic waste.

Spray cans



If you cannot empty the cans, please contact Garbage Collection Office TEL983-7611

Used batteries



 \Rightarrow Put batteries in a semi-transparent bag and place it seperately.

Acceptable batteries

Cylindrical manganese/alkaline batteries and lithium coin cell batteries (CR or BR types)





Plastic containers and packaging (Recyclable plastics)






Packing materials



Packing materials (e.g. styrofoam and bubble wrap) used for shipping home electrical appliances, etc.

Unacceptable items (things can't be recycled)




Cans, glass bottles & PET bottles

Paper, clothes & textiles Collection day **※** Please utilize recycling programs run by community/children's associations if possible. Proceeds from such recycling programs fund their activities ※ Paper is collected also in rainy days. Acceptable items Newspaper Fold and bundle crosswise with string Inserts can be put out together. Cardbord Flatten and bundle crosswise with string Remove any adhesive tape Cardboard with aluminum/wax coating →Discard as burnable garbage Milk/juice cartons Rinse. cut open and dry



Paper, clothes & textiles

Bundle items of the same size with string.

Items lined with aluminum foil \rightarrow Discard as burnable garbage

Magazines & catalogs





Remove any non-paper material(e.g. supplementary CDs, plastic parts, leather/cloth covers) →Discard as burnable garbage

Other Paper

Any paper except for newspapers, cardboard, milk/juice cartons, magazines and catalogs are categorized as "Other paper".

Bundle crosswise with string.

 \Rightarrow Put items into semi-transparent/paper bags, and bundle with string to prevent any slippage.

Please DO NOT include the items below as

Soiled paper, aluminum foil, aluminum/wax-coated paper, carbon-backed paper, and heat transfer printing paper. →Discard as burnable garbage

Clothes & textiles

Items must be laundered and dry. Put them in semi-transparent bags. The acceptable items include clothes (e.g. shirts, trousers, jackets etc.), bed sheets, brackets, and curtains

Soiled or torn items, shoes, leather items, fur products, and cushions →Discard as burnable garbage

Carpets, mattresses and futons →Discard as oversized garbage

Wet items are not accepted for recycling. Please <u>DO NOT</u> place items on rainy days. Use the next collection service, the recycling bins in your neighborhood, or the Center Recycling service (P.14).

Collected items are mostly sent overseas for reuse.

Oversized garbage

Collection of items exceeding 30cm long (metal products), or 50cm (others-plastic or wood products etc.) is subject to fees. They are NOT collected on the regular collection days. Please contact the following to arrange the collection day and the fee.
